Brief History of Issue - why the issue is being considered:

The Department of Kinesiology requests the elimination of the Undergraduate Athletic Training, Comprehensive Major (Code 995-060). The elimination was supported by the faculty in the Department of Kinesiology. The Department of Kinesiology voted to establish the Master of Science in Athletic Training program; thus, the undergraduate program in Athletic Training is no longer needed. Further, all undergraduate Athletic Training education programs must transition to the graduate level to continue accreditation status as established by the Commission on the Accreditation of Athletic Training Education (CAATE).

Points Discussed by Committee:

1. Impact on current students in the major.
2. Future undergraduate students will be able to declare any major on campus with the designated Pre-Athletic Training Professional track that prepares students for entry into professional degree programs through organized academic planning and preparation.
3. Recommendation was supported by the College of Education and Human Sciences Curriculum Committee.
