**UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-EAU CLAIRE
STUDENT SENATE RESOLUTION**

IN SUPPORT of DEPARTMENTAL FEEDBACK AND GRADING TIMEFRAMES

1 WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire (UWEC) Student Senate is the official voice of
2 the student body; and

3 WHEREAS, the UWEC Student Senate holds the responsibility of advocating for the student body
4 while offering equitable solutions for all parties at our institution; and

5 WHEREAS, the ongoing issue of communication between faculty and students has been escalated
6 during the Coronavirus Pandemic, especially in terms of timely grading, feedback, email correspondence,
7 and lenience with the emotional stresses associated; and

8 WHEREAS, while students also struggle with actively answering and communicating with faculty
9 over email, there remains a growing concern with faculty not grading in a timely manner; and

10 WHEREAS, however, there is a clear distinction between the role of those who are students, and
11 those who are educators; and

12 WHEREAS, there is an expectation on behalf of students when enrolling for courses that their
13 contributions in the classroom be assessed in a timely and consistent way; and

14 WHEREAS, while most faculty members excel in responsiveness and feedback, those who do not
15 threaten the reputation of UW-Eau Claire's unmatched academics and faculty; and

16 WHEREAS, without a universally accepted timeframe for grades and feedback to be published,
17 students may not be aware of their standing within a class prior to withdraw deadlines; and

18 WHEREAS, moreover, students may not improve on subsequent assignments with the absence of
19 feedback for their prior work, damaging the entire framework of academia at this institution; and

20 WHEREAS, the need for the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire to commit to a widespread
21 expectation for grading grows, especially during the aftermath of emergency situations like the current
22 pandemic; and

23 WHEREAS, a clear understanding of when students can expect their work to be graded, assuming
24 it is submitted at a previously agreed upon deadline, will also encourage students to build strong and
25 meaningful communication with their respective faculty members; and

26 WHEREAS, this timeframe should be included in all syllabuses, which we continue to encourage
27 be distributed no later than the first week of course meetings; and

28 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the UWEC Student Senate encourages all faculty to include a
29 universal timeframe for grading in their syllabuses, and strongly abide by it; and

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, we also urge the University Senate and all relevant committees to
31 require faculty to incorporate this timeframe in their syllabuses; and

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, should the Deans of the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire not see the
33 risks of abstaining from assigning such a timeframe, we push all individual department chairs and faculty
34 to actively incorporate one in their courses; and

35 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage, President Ziebell will transmit a copy of this resolution
