Brief History of Issue - why the issue is being considered:

The Center for International Education (CIE) is requesting to close both close American College of Thessaloniki (ACT) Greece [INTA 362-Summer AND 363-Semester/Year] & Semester at Sea, Colorado State University [INTA 424]. ACT is no longer a viable site for business students due to the College of Business AACSB-accreditation requirements. Few students have taken advantage of the Semester at Sea program since its inception and the cost of the programs makes it prohibitive for most students.

1. Current participation status of study abroad programs as travel restrictions amongst countries persist due to the pandemic.
