The following motions were approved at the Management and Marketing Department meeting on 8/25/2022. Realizing that some motions are contingent upon approval of others, we ask that these changes move through shared governance as required:

1. Create a new course prefix "OSCM"

Rationale: The Operations and Supply Chain Management courses will be housed in the newly created Marketing and Supply Chain Management department. These courses currently use the MGMT prefix which will remain housed in another department (yet to be named).

2. Contingent on approval of (1) above, change the prefixes of the following courses. All course titles, prerequisites, course descriptions, etc. are unchanged with the exception implied by motion (4) below.

3. Contingent on approval of (1) above, create four new courses. (Leaving the corresponding MGMT courses intact.) (We expect OSCM 398 will be added to the credit limit policy for BSAD 398, MGMT 398, and MKTG 398 under separate motion. The OSCM course description below stands independent of those changes.)

OSCM 398 Internship Program I (1-3 crs)

Prerequisite: MGMT 341. Minimum junior standing.

Consent: Department Consent Required

• Acceptance in Internship Program. See description under College of Business. A maximum of three credits of <u>BSAD 398</u>, <u>MGMT 398</u>, **OSCM 398** and <u>MKTG 398</u> may be applied to the 120-credit graduation requirement. Students must have the service-learning option approved prior to starting the Internship.

Prerequisite: Minimum senior standing. Consent: Department Consent Required

Individual project under the direction of a faculty member.

Repeat: Course may be repeated

4. Contingent on approval of (1) and (2) above:

- (a) Replace all instances of courses listed in motion (2) above to use the OSCM-prefixed courses in the program requirements for any major/minor/certificate etc. (Any program wishing to remove any of the OSCM programs from their program requirements are free to do so under separate motion.)
- (b) Replace all instances of courses listed in motion (2) above to use the OSCM-prefixed courses in the course prerequisites for any course.
- (c) In the requirements for the Operations and Supply Chain Management major use OSCM 398, OSCM 498, OSCM 399, OSCM 499 in place of the existing MGMT prefix courses.
- (d) Implement any additional catalog changes that naturally follow from the changes described above.
