Brief History of Issue - why the issue is being considered:

The College of Business requests approval to establish a new course prefix: (ENT) Entrepreneurship. The Entrepreneurship major was approved in spring of 2022; the courses will be housed in the proposed Management and Leadership Programs department. Currently these courses use the MGMT prefix which though housed in the same department, do not reflect the specificity of entrepreneurship content. All course titles, prerequisites, course descriptions, etc. are unchanged with the exception implied by motion. The new prefix will be used initially for the following courses:
