Brief History of Issue - why the issue is being considered:

The Department of Languages requests the suspension of the German, Major-Liberal Arts (Code 280-201). Reductions in enrollment, faculty, and course array necessitates this suspension.

Points Discussed by Committee:

1. Elimination of major instead of suspension

Pros of Recommendation:

Enrollment has diminished in the German, Major-Liberal Arts. Currently four students are enrolled in the program; all of these students will have access to necessary coursework and study abroad to meet their remaining graduation requirements. Suspension was chosen to monitor interest, rather than immediate elimination of the program.
