

UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-EAU CLAIRE - STUDENT SENATE RESOLUTION

**IN SUPPORT OF THE SPRING 2022
LEGISLATIVE PRIORITY SUMMARY**

1 WHEREAS, The University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire (UW - Eau Claire) Student Senate is the official
2 voice of the student body; and

3 WHEREAS, Chapter IV, Section 11, Part 2, Subsection 1 of the UW – Eau Claire Student Senate
4 bylaws requires a Legislative Priority Summary be drafted by the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission
5 and approved by the commission and Senate General Assembly each semester; and

6 WHEREAS, Chapter IV, Section 11, Part 2, Subsection 3 of the UW – Eau Claire Student Senate
7 bylaws requires that the Legislative Priority Summary be formulated and voted on by the IGA Commission
8 for simple majority approval by no later than the second Student Senate meeting in February; and

9 WHEREAS, the summary shall first be approved by the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission
10 through a simple majority by appointed voting members; and

11 WHEREAS, the summary shall then be introduced and voted on by the Senate General Assembly
12 at the next possible meeting; and

13 WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission approved of this version of the Legislative
14 Priority Summary (See Attachment “A”) at its meeting on Wednesday, February 16 2022, with a vote of 4-
15 0-2; and

16 WHEREAS, the next Student Senate General Assembly meeting following this passage by the
17 commission is February 21, 2022; and

18 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, these policy positions are provided as the Spring 2022 Legislative
19 Priority Summary (See Attachment “A”); and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, upon passage of this resolution, directors of commissions that are
21 explicitly stated within the Legislative Priority Summary will work with the Intergovernmental Affairs
22 Commission to ensure that these initiatives are seen to fruition; and

23 BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, the UW – Eau Claire Student Senate supports the Spring 2022 Legislative
24 Priority Summary, and adopts this as the official policy priorities for the Intergovernmental Affairs
25 Commission and Student Senate General Assembly; and

26 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage of this resolution, President Mikoulskii will transmit
