1. WHEREAS, The Bylaws of the student senate are the official operating policies of the

3. WHEREAS, The amendments made in the previous session were minimal, and did not
4. fix some of the remaining large issues; and
5. WHEREAS, The Student Senate is the voice and representative body of the students
6. ; and
7. WHEREAS, In order to maintain a professional appearance, amendments to the bylaws
8. must be made; and
9. WHEREAS, The proposed amendments shown in attachment “A” and detailed in
10. attachment “B” outline grammatical, clarifying, and changes to impractical or redundant
11. statements; and
12. WHEREAS, Bylaw amendments do not need to pass through the Internal Affairs
13. Committee; and
14. WHEREAS, The amendments in the attachment were made with the assistance and
15. consultation of the president and parliamentarian of the 65th session; and
16. BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the amendments in attachment “A” be adopted
17. and take immediate effect; and
