10	BE IT RESOLVED, the project has been made a part of the Service-Learning Program; and
11	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the project will count as outreach hours if a senator takes on the
12	responsibility of cleaning and emptying the bins; and
13	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the student senate will fund donation bins as detailed in Attachment
14	A, which will be placed into every residence hall in order to support the campus food pantry & closet as
15	stated within the IGA LPS; and
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, after move-in and move-out day, the bins will be emptied that day if
17	the bins have gathered donations; an
