1            WHEREAS, the campus closet & food pantry are resources that are heavily utilized by students;

3            WHEREAS, the campus food pantry & closet fully relies on donations; and  
4            WHEREAS, to the knowledge of the senate, there are no permanent donation bins for the  
5 campus closet in the dorms; and  
6            WHEREAS, to the knowledge of the senate, there are no permanent donation bins for the  
7 campus food pantry in the dorms; and  
8            WHEREAS, the student senate is able to completely fund this project; and  
9            WHEREAS, the administration in charge of housing is in support of this resolution; and  
10          BE IT RESOLVED, the project has been made a part of the Service-Learning Program; and  
11          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the project will count as outreach hours if a senator takes on the  
12 responsibility of cleaning and emptying the bins; and  
13          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the student senate will fund donation bins as detailed in Attachment  
14 A, which will be placed into every residence hall in order to support the campus food pantry & closet as  
15 stated within the IGA LPS; and  
16          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, after move-in and move-out day, the bins will be emptied that day if  
17 the bins have gathered donations; an  
18          BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage of this resolution, President Gaitan will transmit a  
19 copy to Dr. James Schmidt, Chancellor; Dr. Patricia Kleine, Provost and Vice Chancellor, Academic  
20 Affairs; Grace Crickette, Vice Chancellor, Finance and Administration; Billy Felz, Vice Chancellor of  
21 Enrollment Management; Brian Drollinger, Director of Risk Management, Safety, and Sustainability;
