**BILL: AMENDING CHAPTER III, SECTION 3, PART 8 & 9 + CHAPTER IV,
SECTION 9, PART 7 & 8**

1 WHEREAS, the bylaws of the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire (UW-Eau
2 Claire) Student Senate provide specific policy and procedural interpretations of the
3 Student Body Constitution; and

4 WHEREAS, the most recent alterations to the bylaws were made in the 64th
5 Student Senate session; and

6 WHEREAS, in order to operate in an ethical and equitable capacity, the Equity in
7 Student Matters Commission of the 66th Session has revised the roles for both the Student
8 and Senate Director to account for shared responsibilities between the two roles; and

9 WHEREAS, the Equity in Student Matters Commission of the 66th Session has
10 revised the budget process for the ESM Organized Activity budget to address confusion
11 since its implementation; and

12 WHEREAS, the amendments proposed are in in Attachment A; and

13 WHEREAS, this change also provides the Equity in Student Matters Commission
14 with the ability to better acknowledge issues of equity within the organization’s
15 procedures; and

16 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Student Senate of the UW-Eau Claire
17 officially amend the bylaws reflected in attachment “A;” and

18 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage of this bill, President Gaitán will
