## UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-EAU CLAIRE STUDENT SENATE

BILL: Creation of an Ad-Hoc Vacancy Committee for the 67<sup>th</sup> Session

1 2	WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire (UW-Eau Claire) Student Senate is the official voice of the student body; and
3 4 5	WHEREAS, every Spring semester, a student body election is conducted to fill 30 Student Senate seats, as well as the offices of Student Body President and Student Body Vice-President; and
6 7	WHEREAS, Senator seats that are not filled upon the certification of the election results, or that become empty due to the resignation of a Senator are deemed "vacant"; and
8 9	WHEREAS, vacancies are common occurrence following an election and throughout each session; and
10 11	WHEREAS, the process of filling vacancies includes the creation of an ad-hoc Vacancy Committee; and
12 13	WHEREAS, per the bylaws, the passage of a bill is required for the creation of an ad-hoc committee; and
14	WHEREAS, the Vacancy Committee shall be chaired by the Student Body Vice-President; and
15	WHEREAS, the Vacancy Committee shall be co-chaired by the Student Body President; and
16 17	WHEREAS, the Senate Personnel Director shall have a dedicated seat on the Vacancy Committee; and
18 19 20	WHEREAS, other than the chair, co-chair, and Senate Personnel Director, the Vacancy Committee shall be composed of no more than two Student Senators, and no more than two members of the Executive Board; and
21 22	WHEREAS, the purpose of this committee is to review the applications of interested students, and to interview candidates who meet the criteria for Student Senator seats; and
23 24 25	WHEREAS, following bylaw revisions in the spring of 2022, the filling of vacancies is no longer beholden to the on-campus and off-campus distinction of the student body election process, but rathe all vacancies assessed on an "at-large" basis; and
26 27	WHEREAS, the Ad-Hoc Vacancy Committee may consider all candidates in the previous election who completed petitions as automatic applicants to the vacancy process; and

28 WHEREAS, it is the at the discretion of the chair how to conduct and structure the interview 29 process for applicants; and 30 WHEREAS, following this process, the Vacancy Committee relays its recommendations for the 31 exact amount of current vacancies to the Student Body President for confirmation and to be appointed; 32 and 33 WHEREAS, the Vacancy Committee may also relay additional recommendations to be 34 considered automatically and appointed to fill any future vacancies; and 35 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, following the passage of this bill, this Ad-Hoc Committee will 36 be formed immediately following the start (the appointments of the newly-elected senators) of 37 the 67<sup>th</sup> session; and 38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the filling of seats on the Vacancy Committee shall be 39 done by the normal nomination process within Personnel following the passage of this bill; and 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this ad-hoc committee shall be dissolved automatically following the final vacancy process of the 67<sup>th</sup> session, upon the conclusion of the 67<sup>th</sup> session, or 41 at the discretion of the chair; and 42 43 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage of this bill, President Gaitán will transmit a copy of this bill to Dr. James Schmidt, Chancellor; Greggory Heinselman, Dean of Students; Dr. 44 45 Patricia Kleine, Provost and Vice Chancellor, Academic Affairs; Grace Crickette, Vice Chancellor, 46 Finance and Administration; Billy Felz, Interim Vice Chancellor, Enrollment Management; Teresa 47 O'Halloran, Interim Assistant Chancellor of EDI; Selika Ducksworth, Interim Executive Director for 48 EDI Engagement; Evan Weiher, Chair, University Senate; Quincy Nesgoda, Student Body 49 President, UW Eau Claire-Barron County; Gary Wheeler, Interim Campus Director, UW Eau Claire-50 **Barron County**
