

**UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-EAU CLAIRE
STUDENT SENATE RESOLUTION**

IN SUPPORT OF THE FALL 2022 LEGISLATIVE PRIORITY SUMMARY

1 WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire (UW-Eau Claire) Student Senate is the official
2 voice of the student body; and

3 WHEREAS, Chapter IV, Section 11, Part 2, Subsection 1 of the UW – Eau Claire Student Senate
4 bylaws requires a Legislative Priority Summary be drafted by the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission
5 and approved by the commission and senate general assembly each semester; and

6 WHEREAS, of the UW – Eau Claire Student Senate bylaws requires a Legislative Priority Summary
7 be drafted by the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission and approved by the commission and senate
8 general assembly each semester; and

9 WHEREAS, the summary shall first be approved by the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission
10 through a simple majority by appointed voting members; and

11 WHEREAS, the summary shall then be introduced and voted on by the senate general assembly
12 at the next possible meeting; and

13 WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission approved of this version of the Legislative
14 Priority Summary at its meeting on Tuesday, September 20, 2022, with a unanimous vote of 5-0-0; and

15 WHEREAS, the next Student Senate meeting following this passage by the commission is
16 September 26, 2022; and

17 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, these policy positions are provided as the Fall 22 Legislative Priority
18 Summary (See Attachment “A”) ; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, upon passage of this resolution, directors of commissions that are
20 explicitly stated in the Legislative Priority Summary will work with the Intergovernmental Affairs
21 Commission to ensure that these initiatives are seen to fruition; and

22 BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, the UW – Eau Claire Student Senate supports the Fall 2022 Legislative
23 Priority Summary, and adopts this as the official policy priorities for the Intergovernmental Affairs
24 Commission and general assembly; and

25 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage of this resolution, President Gaitán will transmit a
26 copy of this bill to Dr. James Schmidt, Chancellor; Gregory Heinselman, Dean of Students; Dr. Patricia
27 Kleine, Provost and Vice Chancellor, Academic Affairs; Olga Diaz, Vice Chancellor, Equity, Diversity,
28 Inclusion and Student Affairs; Grace Crickette, Vice Chancellor, Finance and Administration; Billy Felz,
29 Interim Vice Chancellor, Enrollment Management; Evan Weiher, Chair, University Senate; Quincy
30 Nesgoda, Student Body President, UW Eau Claire-Barron County; Gary Wheeler, Interim Campus Director,
