**Student Office of Sustainability Fall 2022 Priorities Summary**

1           WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire (UW-Eau Claire) Student Senate is the official  
2 voice of the student body; and

3           WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin Eau Claire is committed to the values “of sustainability and  
4 commitment to preserving and enhancing not only the natural beauty of our campuses, but also our built  
5 environment and the relationships that define the health and equity of our communities and region”  
6 (Strategic Plan 2025); and

7           WHEREAS, the Student Office of Sustainability is committed to allocating student dollars, in  
8 accordance with UW (University of Wisconsin) System 820 policy, toward sustainable initiatives that  
9 directly benefit our students; and

10           WHEREAS, the Student Office of Sustainability recognizes sustainability is found at the  
11 intersection of public wellbeing, ecological health, and economic prosperity; and

12           WHEREAS, section 14, part 6, subsection 1 of the UW-Eau Claire Student Senate bylaws requires  
13 that the Student Office of Sustainability develop and approve a priorities document to be approved both  
14 by the commission and by the Student Senate; and

15           WHEREAS, the Student Office of Sustainability’s General Assembly passed Attachment A with a  
16 vote of 5-0-0 in support of the Student Office of Sustainability Fall 2022 Priorities Summary

17           BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the University of Wisconsin – Eau Claire Student Senate  
18 supports 16 the Fall 2021 Student Office of Sustainability Priorities Document and adopts it was official  
19 priorities for 17 the Student Office of Sustainability and wider Student Senate; and

20           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon passage of this resolution, the Student Office of  
21 Sustainability commission works collaboratively with members of the Student Senate and the wider  
22 student body to support these priorities; and
