

**UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-EAU CLAIRE
STUDENT SENATE RESOLUTION**

FISCAL YEAR 2024 NON-ALLOCABLE SEGREGATED FEE APPROVAL

1 WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin Board of Regents requires that each campus have a
2 Segregated University Fee Allocation Committee (SUFAC) to appropriate portions of the segregated fees;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin - Eau Claire Student Senate holds the responsibility of
5 appropriately allocating segregated fees; and

6 WHEREAS, Student Senate Finance Commission leadership meets with each non-allocable
7 organization individually while designing their budget; and

8 WHEREAS, the Student Senate Finance Commission reviews each proposed non-allocable budget
9 and gives Student Senate its recommendations; and

10 WHEREAS, the Finance Commission has completed its process of research, review, budget
11 presentation, upon which has adopted recommendations for the fiscal year 2024 non-allocable
12 Segregated Fees; and

13 WHEREAS, several organizations will continue to experience loss of revenue and increased costs
14 into the next fiscal year; and

15 WHEREAS, loss of revenue is primarily attributed to the decrease in enrollment that is projected
16 for the next fiscal year; and

17 WHEREAS, increased operating costs are primarily attributed to the lingering effects of the COVID-
18 19 pandemic on the economy, inflation, and contractual obligations associated with operating costs; and

19 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Student Senate adopts the non-allocable budget
20 recommendation (Attachment "A"); and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Student Senate adopts the non-allocable segregated Fee of
22 \$1,491.51 representing a 5.88% increase in the non-allocable Segregated Fee from the previous year; and

23 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage of this bill, President Gaitan will transmit a copy to
