

**UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-EAU CLAIRE  
STUDENT SENATE RESOLUTION**

**In Support of the Fall 2023 Legislative Priority Summary**

1           WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire (UW-Eau Claire) Student Senate is the official voice of the  
2 student body; and

3           WHEREAS, Chapter IV, Section 11, Part 2, Subsection 1 of the UW-Eau Claire Student Senate bylaws requires  
4 a Legislative Priority Summary by drafted by the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission and approved by the  
5 commission and senate general assembly each semester; and

6           WHEREAS, the summary shall first be approved by the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission through a  
7 simple majority by appointed voting members; and

8           WHEREAS, the summary shall then be introduced and voted on by the senate general assembly at the next  
9 possible meeting; and

10           WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission approved to this version of the Legislative Priority  
11 Summary at its meeting on Tuesday, September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023, with a unanimous vote of 9-0-0; and

12           WHEREAS, the next Student Senate meeting following this passage by the commission is October 2, 2023;

14           BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, these policy positions are provided as the Fall 23 Legislative Priority Summary  
15 (See Attachment "A"); and

16           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, upon passage of this resolution, directors of commissions that are explicitly  
17 stated in the Legislative Priority Summary will work with the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission to ensure that  
18 these initiatives are seen to fruition; and

19           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The UW-Eau Claire Student Senate Supports the Fall 2023 Legislative Priority  
20 Summary, and adopts this as the official policy priorities for the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission and general  
21 Assembly; and

22           BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage of this resolution, President Farmer will transmit a copy of this  
23 bill to Dr. James Schmidt, Chancellor; Gregory Heinselman, Dean of Students; Dr. Patricia Kleine, Provost and Vice  
24 Chancellor, Academic Affairs; Grace Crickette, Vice Chancellor, Finance and Administration; Billy Felz, Interim Vice  
25 Chancellor, Enrollment Management; Teresa O'Halloran, Interim Assistant Chancellor of EDI; Selika Ducksworth,  
26 Interim Executive Director for EDI Engagement; Evan Weiher, Chair, University Senate; Quincy Nesgoda, Student
