Student Office of Sustainability Fall 2023 Priorities Summary

1 WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire (UW-Eau Claire) Student Senate is
 2 the official voice of the student body; and

3 WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin Eau Claire is committed to the values “of
 4 sustainability and commitment to preserving and enhancing not only the natural beauty of our
 5 campuses, but also our built environment and the relationships that define the health and equity of
 6 our communities and region” (Strategic Plan 2025); and

7 WHEREAS, the Student Office of Sustainability is committed to allocating student dollars,
 8 in accordance with UW (University of Wisconsin) System 820 policy, toward sustainable
 9 initiatives that directly benefit our students; and

10 WHEREAS, the Student Office of Sustainability recognizes sustainability is found at the
 11 intersection of public wellbeing, ecological health, and economic prosperity; and

12 WHEREAS, section 14, part 6, subsection 1 of the UW-Eau Claire Student Senate bylaws
 13 requires that the Student Office of Sustainability develop and approve a priorities document to be
 14 approved both by the commission and by the Student Senate; and

15 WHEREAS, the Student Office of Sustainability’s General Assembly provided ideas for
 16 attachment A and are in support of the Student Office of Sustainability Fall 2023 Priorities
 17 Summary

18 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the University of Wisconsin – Eau Claire Student
 19 Senate supports the Fall 2023 Student Office of Sustainability Priorities Document and adopts it
 20 as official priorities for the Student Office of Sustainability and wider Student Senate; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon passage of this resolution, the Student Office of
 22 Sustainability commission works collaboratively with members of the Student Senate and the
 23 wider student body to support these priorities; and
