In Support of and Recognizing National Coming Out Day

WHEREAS, National Coming out day will be celebrated by many allied and LGBTQIA+ 1 2 individuals at the University of Wisconsin Eau Claire on Friday, October 11th. 3 WHEREAS, for decades, policies and attitudes in the United States have made it extremely 4 difficult for LGBTQIA+ identifying individuals to be open about their identities to their family, friends, neighbors and coworkers, because of the potential threats to their safety, and risk of 5 6 bullying, harassment and persecution that a queer individual would likely face. 7 WHEREAS, it takes a tremendous amount of courage, preparation, consideration and 8 deliberation for an individual who decides to come out given the threats and risks associated with 9 doing so. 10 WHEREAS, despite major progress in expanding the rights of LGBTQIA+ individuals, 11 those same rights are currently under attack by homophobic and transphobic policy makers. 12 WHEREAS, the same risk of bullying, harassment and persecution, as well as threats to a 13 queer individual's safety exist, despite it being much easier to openly, and proudly identify as 14 LGBTQIA+. WHEREAS, it is the duty of the University of Wisconsin Eau Claire Student Senate to 15 16 diligently serve and protect the students of this university, including those who identify as 17 LGBTQIA+. WHEREAS, through the diligent work of the Gender and Sexualities Resource Center, and 18 19 the Queer campus community, The University of Wisconsin Eau Claire has made significant 20 strides in creating an inclusive and welcoming campus community for those who identify as 21 LGBTQIA+ 22 WHEREAS, as a result of this work, The University of Wisconsin Eau Claire has earned a 5 star rating from Campus Pride. Additionally, The University of Wisconsin Eau Claire has been 23 24 placed by Best Colleges and Campus Pride in the top 25 schools in the nation, and the best in the 25 State of Wisconsin for its inclusivity of LGBTQIA+ people.

35	Eau Claire renews its commitment to working for the advancement and protection of the
36	LGBTQIA+ campus community, and hereby recognizes that EDI contributes greatly to the
