#### **CHAASE SPRING BANQUET**

Every year, outstanding students, preceptors, and friends of the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire Health Care Administration
Program are recognized at the annual spring banquet hosted by the UW-Eau Claire Center for Health Administration and Aging Services Excellence (CHAASE). This year's event was held on April 20th at The Lismore in Eau Claire, WI.

This year's keynote speaker was LaShuan Bethea, Executive Director for the National Center for Assisted Living. She is a registered nurse and attorney who works with providers across the country to advocate for laws and regulations that improve resident outcomes within assisted living.

With more than 25 years of experience in health care, Bethea began her career in 1995 as a licensed practical nurse in a skilled nursing facility. She has held many roles throughout her career in both acute and post-acute settings, ranging from emergency room nursing and acute care behavioral health to long term care direct care nurse to vice president of legislative affairs for a skilled nursing facility.

As part of her advocacy efforts, Bethea frequently meets with long term care providers, state and federal legislators and administrative agencies to discuss issues related to workforce and labor challenges, Medicare and Medicaid, and the impact of the pandemic on long term care.

Bethea earned a master's degree in Education with a minor in Instructional Design from American Intercontinental University, a Bachelor of Science in Nursing from the University of Phoenix, and a Juris Doctorate from Widener University School of Law.




# **ACHCA CONVOCATION**








## **WISCONSIN HOSA**

counselors.




# NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH (NCUR)
