Please note:

*If you are still under 42 completed credits in spring but can meet all non-Administrative Residency (Practicum) degree requirements by May 2025, and want to start administrative residency in June 2025, YOU SHOULD STILL APPLY THIS SPRING, since **SPRING 2024 is the LAST opportunity to apply for a spot in the 2025-26 administrative residency cohort!**

** On occasion, Conditional Admission or a Deferred Decision may be considered for those below the minimum GPA, dependent on circumstances and available space.




Once you access the online application, you will provide information about yourself (information can be found on your **degree audit** and **unofficial transcript**). You will also need to upload pdf **files** of the following documents:

- HCAD Application Essay
- Planner Report
- ARCC Advisor email/signature approving your plan
- Unofficial Transcript

Step #1 - Degree Audit (more information about degree audits)

- Log into Camps
- On the Student Homepage, select the Academic Progress tile



From the menu, select Degree Audit



Select the option to "View Report as PDF"



Save your Degree Audit as a PDF. You should name your document "Your Last Name Degree Audit". For example, "Smith Degree Audit."


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Step #2 - Academic Plan

Using your resources, develop a semester-by-semester plan in your <u>CampS Planner</u> to complete **ALL** degree requirements. Resources include:

- Your Degree Audit
- HCAD 4-Year Sample Plan (can be found in the catalog)
- Meet with your ARCC Advisor



Step #3 – Planner Report

Once your CampS Planner is complete and accurate, generate a degree audit based on your planner.

- The on-line version of your Planner Report will appear. Select "view report as pdf".
- Read over your pdf Planner Report carefully and be sure all requirements are satisfied (except admission to HCAD).
- Save your Degree Audit as a PDF. You should name your document "Your Last Name Planner Report". For example, "Smith Planner Report."



Step #4 – ARCC Advisor Approval

- Five business days prior to the application deadline or sooner, e-mail the PDF version of your Planner Report to your ARCC Advisor for review.
- When your ARCC Advisor replies and approves your plan, save that e-mail as a PDF so you can upload it with your other application documents.

Step #5 – Unofficial Transcript

- Generate your <u>unofficial transcript</u> in MyBlugold CampS (click on the link for a short tutorial)
- Save your unofficial Transcript as a PDF. You should name your document "Your Last Name Unofficial Transcript". For example, "Smith Unofficial Transcript."

Step #6 – Essay

- Start early!
- Your essay (and application) will be evaluated on how well thought out and written it is, as well as how you address the questions below.
- Be concise; the essay should not exceed two, double-spaced pages.
- We want to know how your participation in the program will add value to you, your classmates, the program, and the profession.
- We recommend utilizing the <u>Business Writing Studio</u> and the <u>Center for Writing</u> <u>Excellence</u>
 - What do you bring or have to offer the HCAD program and your future classmates?
 - Why do you want to receive a degree in Health Care Administration?
 - What have you done to prepare yourself for a future in Health Care
 Administration (work or volunteer experiences, books, or articles you've read, activities you participated in, etc.)?
 - What do you see yourself doing in five to ten years?
