


How to log onto Gold for Blugolds scholarship website

Step 1.

Step 2.

Log into your account using your Blugold credentials. (the same log in you would use to log into D2L or your E-mail.) Then click Log In

Step 4.

Categories: Selecting multiple categories will return all scholarships meeting any one of the selected categories. The more categories selected the more scholarships will be returned.

Keyword(s): Entering a keyword or phrase will return all scholarship that contain the exact keyword or phrase within the scholarship name or description. Keywords filter the scholarships returned by the Categories.
