RESEARCH FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

These grants support students in research, scholarly, and creative activity with a faculty/staff member.

SUMMER RESEARCH EXPERIENCES FOR UNDERGRADUATES

Facilitates summer projects.

STUDENT-FACULTY RESEARCH COLLABORATION Supports academic year projects.

DIVERSITY MENTORING PROGRAM Supports students of color and/or low-income students.

INTERNATIONAL FELLOWS PROGRAM Funds short-term projects abroad.

BLUGOLD BIOMEDICAL INNOVATOR PROGRAM

Ten incoming students receive scholarships and guaranteed research opportunities with UWEC faculty mentors and Mayo Clinic Health System professionals.

TRAVEL FUNDING

Travel awards provide funding for students presenting the results of collaborative research and creative activity at professional meetings and conferences.
